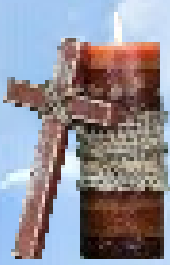
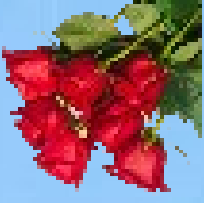
Jimmy worked as a security guard in his early years. He then worked for Maher Terminal for 23 years and at M&T Bank until his illness prevented him to continue working.

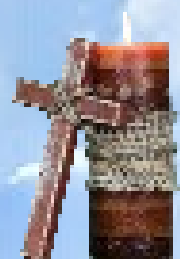
Jimmy loved to fish and crab. He enjoyed cookouts, traveling and spending time with his family. He was a father figure to the entire family. He was definitely the life of the party.
