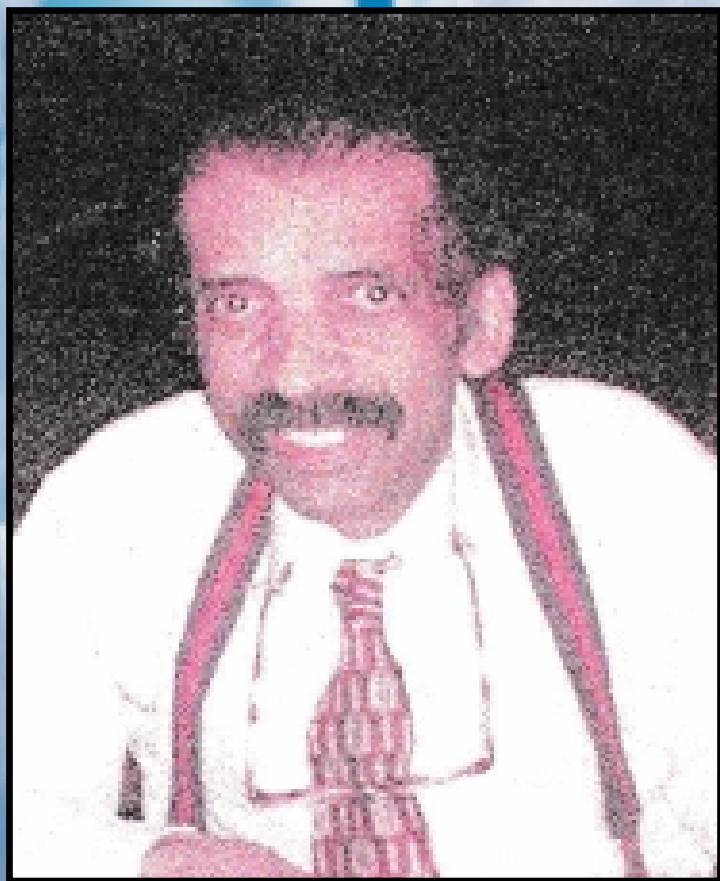

Obituary

Douglas P. Dabney was born on February 14, 1947 in Jersey City, NJ at the Margaret Hague Hospital to William and Marie Dabney Smith.

Douglas graduated from P.S. 22 and Lincoln High School in 1967. He later graduated from St. Peters College with a degree in Journalism. He later went on to become a reporter for the Jersey Journal for a few years before moving to Houston, TX. The passing of his mother brought Douglas home to New Jersey for a minute before moving to Philadelphia, PA to work for the Philadelphia Tribune. Afterwards Douglas worked for Urban League as a job developer helping people to get jobs which he loved to do, he loved to help people and party and vacation with his friends, Vaughn and Hank three peas in a pod and the three amigos.

In 2004 Douglas was diagnosed with Parkinsons Disease. In June 2019 he came to live with his sister, Charmaine whom took on the love of becoming his caretaker with his passing on Thursday, January 23, 2020.

Douglas is preceded in death his father, Williams Dabney, his mother, Marie Dabney Smith, his stepfather, Robert Smith, his sisters, Joan Artist, Linda Major Hall, Dianne Ahmad and his brothers, Thomas Dabney, and Richard Dabney.
