**Levone Recarter Drummer** was born to John Wesley and Mary Elizabeth Drummer on December 1, 1956 in Welch, West Virginia. His parents preceded him in death, leaving his two oldest sisters Mary and Minnie Drummer to continue the parenting of their seven (7) younger siblings, resulting in a lifelong loving bond never to be broken. Upon relocating from West Virginia to Buffalo, New York, Levone's Uncle and Aunt William and Helen Moore continued to assist in the growth and development of him and his siblings.

Levone received his elementary education at Clinton Junior High School in Buffalo, NY, continuing to pursue his high school education at William Howard Taft in the Bronx, New York. He finished his college education at Miles College in Fairfield, Alabama where he majored in Communications and pledged into the Omega Psi Phi fraternity.

In October 2003, Levone married the love of his life, Roberta Evans, and inherited an 11 year old daughter, Morgan Shaw, in the process. He was a great, thoughtful husband and a wonderful father. Over their sixteen year marriage, they enjoyed numerous trips to domestic and international destinations and their love for each other was clearly evident to anyone who spent time in their presence.

Levone dedicated over 30 years of service to the Social Service industry, providing counseling, nurturing, and spiritual guidance to at-risk youth and adults in need of rehabilitation services. He worked with various agencies such as Leake & Watts, Children's Village, Odyssey & Phoenix House, the Department of Corrections and the Department of Parole, just to name a few. In September 2018, Levone retired from The Salvation Army Adult Rehabilitation Center after 23 years of service to the organization.

The kind and loving aura that followed him resulted in the attachment of lifelong friends and relationships. He joined The Friendly Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Albert L. Sutton, Sr. He was a member of the Male Chorus and the brotherhood. Last year, Levone became a walking Deacon, a position he was godly proud to hold.

On January 28, 2020, Levone looked to the hills and proceeded to answer the call coming from his heavenly Father.
