Raymond "Hanif" Smith Jr. was born on March 19, 1970 to Ruth Stokes and Raymond Smith Sr. He was raised in Paterson, NJ.

He attended the local public schools and graduated from Passaic County Technical Institute. He was a great cook. He also enjoyed spending time at the gym and was an avid Dallas Cowboys fan. He was also a GQ connoisseur of name brand sneakers and sweat suits.

Hanif was a Master Barber. He worked in Paterson for more than thirty years. In 1984 he enrolled in cosmetology class in PCTI Wayne. His first official job was at Community Barbershop on Rosa Parks Blvd. In the late 1980's he fine tuned his skills and made a name for himself at Hair Affair Barbershop on West Broadway downtown Paterson under the training and mentorship of Eric Jones. After the passing of his mentor Eric Jones he left Hair Affair and began temporary employment at a small shop in East Orange. He returned to Paterson in the early 1990's and began a lead barber position at Turning Heads Unisex Salon on Broadway downtown Paterson, he later connected with a family member and joined the team at a shop called Final Phase located in South Jersey. He again returned to Paterson and began a lead position at Better Look Barbershop on Grand Street. In December 1994 he began a barbering position at Kutt Creators Hair Repair and Accessories Unisex Salon. In 1997 he partnered in a barbershop on Park Avenue called Universal Kutts. Then in 1999 he returned back to Kutt Creators along with three other barbers and formed the Mega 15 Chaired Barbershop, Beauty Salon and Retail Shop titled Simply The Best Unisex Salon. Shortly after 2011 Simply the Best Unisex began DBA Simply Hair Kutts. On October 1, 2019 Simply The Best Barbershop DBA Simply Hair Kutts closed it's doors after 25 years at the 681 East 18th St. location. On Saturday, January 25, 2020 Hanif closed out his 35 year barbering career at Head Quarters Barbershop 528 East 18th St. Paterson, NJ. He loved Paterson and the community which he was committed to serving as a barber.

He was preceded in death by his step-son, Zahmir Hayes, grandparents, William Buck Brown, Virginia Lucy Watkins, Walter Smith, Walter and Mary Slade, aunt, Mina Medley and god father, Robert "Bobby" Alexander.

He departed this life on Tuesday, January 28, 2020 at Hackensack University Medical Center.


