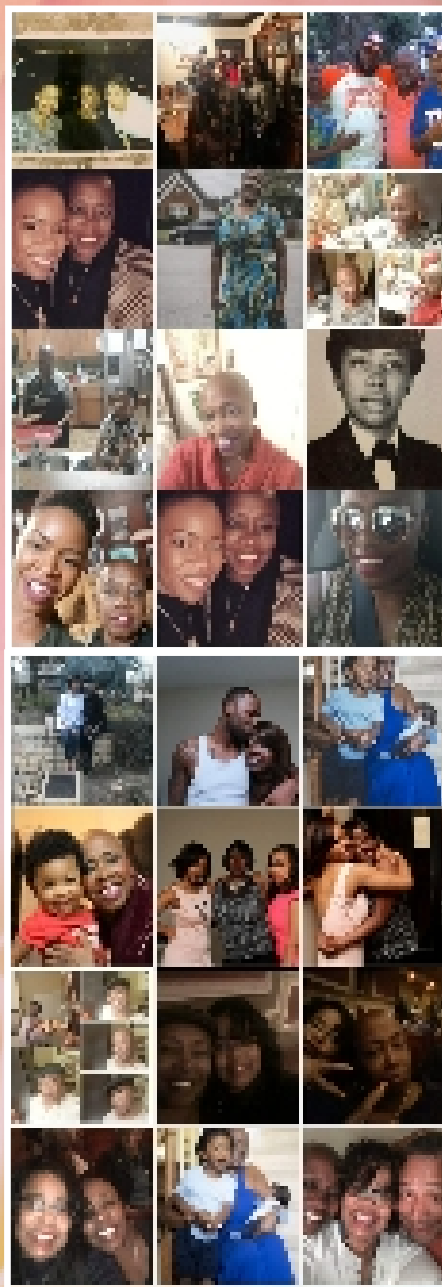


*For a second you were flying
