Donald Damont Jacobs, was born on December 9, 1985. He was the son of Donald Williams and the late Betty Jean Jacobs.

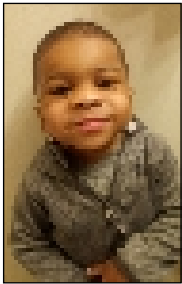

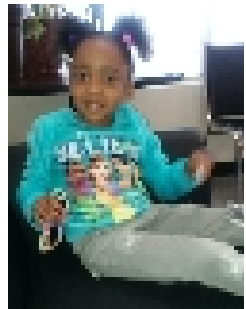
