<u>Life Story of</u> <u>His Grace, Hpostle</u> Franklin Delano Roosevelt Pettiford, Sr.

Apostle Franklin Delano Roosevelt Pettiford achieved many accomplishments in his life, and all the Glory and Honor belong to God. Born September 4, 1932 in Fitzgerald, Georgia, he came to Jersey City, New Jersey at a young age, receiving his education in the public schools there. On January 12, 1951 he united in holy matrimony with the former Annie R. Washington, and they became parents to four children: Franklin, Jr. (deceased), Charles, James, and Pamela.

Aposlte Pettiford was the CEO and proprietor of Pettiford's Fish Market in Jersey City, New Jersey. He was also a certified boiler operator in the Englewood Public School system. He was a licensed barber in Jersey City, New Jersey where he would cut all the boys hair at the Cornerstone Church of Christ. He also served as a Notary Public. He was the founder and owner of Frank's Maintenance Floor Finishing Company.

On March 25, 1956, Apostle Pettiford was baptized in Jesus' Name and received the Holy Ghost at Refuge Church, 35 Kearny Avenue, Jersey City, New Jersey under the pastorate of Elder Grady Dale. The first office he held was the Prayer Band President. Shortly thereafter, he was appointed as a Junior Deacon, and later became Young People's President. In 1957, God called him into the preaching ministry.

In September 1961, Apostle Pettiford came to the Bible Way Church in Paterson, New Jersey to assist the pastor, the late Bishop Robert Norman Jones, Sr. In 1963, he was ordained to the office of Elder, and in 1965, he was installed as Assistant Pastor of the church. On Sunday, December 9, 1973, Elder Pettiford was installed as Pastor of Bible Way Church by Bishop Winfield A. Showell (dec), with Bishop Jones present. With the new mantle on his life, he then enrolled in the Manhattan Bible Institute and received Certificates for Evangelism, General Bible, Teachers' Training, and post-graduate studies. Later, he enrolled in the American Bible College, and received Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral degrees.

In March of 1979, the Lord blessed Apostle Pettiford to lead the congregation from Governor Street to a larger worship center (and the church's current location), located at 20 Southard Street with a seating capacity of 500. At that time, the name of the church became Greater Bible Way. In 1982, Apostle Pettiford opened the R.N. Jones Bible Institute, where he served as president. He also served seven years as the Northern New Jersey District Elder of BWWW after the passing of District Elder Reginald Ford in 1979.

In 1983, the late Apostle Smallwood E. Williams, Chief Prelate of the Bible Way Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ, World Wide, Inc. appointed then-District Elder Pettiford as the Diocesan Overseer of Jamaica, West Indies, where he served for almost 15 years. In 1985, he was consecrated to the Bishopric. In 1987, he was appointed Diocesan Bishop of the State of New Jersey, BWWW. In July 1992, Presiding Prelate Apostle Lawrence G. Campbell appointed then-Bishop Pettiford as the Auxiliary Bishop of the Exhibits, BWWW. On March 16, 1994 during the Bishop's and Worker's Conference, BWWW in Montego Bay, Jamaica, Bishop Pettiford was appointed to the Executive Board of Bishops. On August 11, 1994, Bishop Pettiford received a Doctorate of Philosophy in Christian Education (Ph.D.).

In November 1994, he was appointed to the office of Chairman of the General Board of Bishops, BWWW, by Presiding prelate Apostle Huie L. Rogers.

During his 46-year tenure as Pastor, he has been instrumental in mentoring and developing those in ministry under his leadership. The list includes: Bishop William Cousin, Bishop-Elect Calvin Bey, Elder Anthony Moses (dec.), Bishop James Robinson, Bishop James Wilkerson (dec.), Pastor Kelvin McKinnon, Elder Terence Kitchings, Minister Stace Tisdol, Pastor John Richardson, Bishop Astley McKoy (dec.), Elder Pamela F. Samuels, Dr. Edith McKinnon (dec.), Dr. Jacqueline Coles, Dr. Gloria J. Moody, Pastor Gale C. Richardson, Elder Debra Burgess (dec.), Pastor Linda F. Stancil, Elder Lorraine Lawson, Pastor Jason Moody, Elder Quiana Coley, Elder Josette Boddie, and Elder Avery Moses. Others who went on to develop in ministry beyond their Bible Way membership include: Pastor Allen MacArthur, Pastors Wendell and Kimberly Fleetwood, Minister Stacy Waller, Pastor Eric Wilson and Elder H. Dean Mallory.

In honor of the many achievements and milestones of our Pastor, the Paterson City Council bestowed upon him one of the City's highest honors. On Saturday, December 18, 1999, The Honorable Mayor Martin G. Barnes (Paterson's first African-American Mayor), along with many representatives of the City, County, State and Federal Governments officiated the ceremony officially re-naming Southard Street to "Bishop Franklin Pettiford Plaza". Bishop Pettiford is the first Apostolic minister to receive such an honor in the City of Paterson or in Passaic County.

There have been many other achievements and milestones added to his already-lengthy list. Among the most recent is his being named an Episcopal Bishop in The Bible Way Church, World Wide. At the time, it was a newly established office and Bishop Pettiford was the FIRST to hold this office - truly a trendsetter!! In July 2014, Bishop Pettiford was elevated to the holy office of Apostle in the International Bible Way Church of Jesus Christ, Inc. by then-Presiding Prelate Apostle Floyd E. Nelson (dec.).

In the city of Paterson, he was known and respected by his fellow clergy of various faiths, and was a dedicated member of the Paterson Pastor's Workshop. He was a fixture at one of his favorite eateries, Mr. G's! One of his most distinguished trademarks was his hats! Even without seeing his face, you knew he was in the place! One of his famous lines was, "You need to set your pails out because I see a cloud about the size of a man's hand, and it's going to rain!" This was a sure-fire way to get the church going!

For more than seven decades Apostle Pettiford has dedicated his life to the Lord's service. Truly, his steps have been "Ordered by the Lord!"

Apostle Franklin D. R. Pettiford, Sr. was predeceased by his parents, James and Viola; his step-father, Charles Raines; a son, Franklin "Frankie" Pettiford, Jr. one granddaughter, Sha`Terra Monique Moses; a son-in-law, Elder Anthony "Tony" Moses; siblings: Mayola Brown, Milton Pettiford, Maxine Coleman, Lola George, Ida Mae Johnson and Clara Roberson.

On Monday, Morning February 17, 2020 Apostle Franklin Delano Roosevelt Pettiford, Sr. departed this life and entered eternal rest at the St. Joseph's University Medical Center Paterson, NJ.

He leaves to celebrate his life: his devoted wife of 69 years, Mother Annie R. Pettiford; sons, Charles Wesley (Juanita) of Paterson, James Allen (Diane) of Gastonia, NC; daughter, Elder Pamela Francine Samuels of Clifton, NJ; grandchildren, Rashaan Pettiford, Josetta (Roy) Turner, Shonte' Pettiford, Avery L.
