# Obituary



**Ivy Meredith** was the third of nine children, born to Charles and Urselina Shaw of Vaughansfield, St. James, Jamaica. Very early in life, she left home for Kingston, where she explored different jobs before embarking on small business ventures in the food and shoe industries.

She was married to Kenneth Meredith (deceased) for many years. There, she raised her three children: James, Patrick, and Yvonne. Ivy was a faithful member of the Philadelphia Gospel Assembly. When the couple moved to Cinnamon Crescent, they transferred their membership from Philadelphia to Calvary Gospel Assembly. From this Assembly, Ivy and her husband were commissioned to plant a sister church in Denham Town. There Ivy developed and ran a very successful ministry for women.

Ivy was a visionary, a risk taker, and a very savvy business woman. With God's guidance, she charted her path to a comfortable life for the family by establishing a shoe factory in her home. At the same time she carved out a niche in the food industry by supplying meals to workers at Arrow Shirt Factory. Ivy's ingenuity for survival in colonial days placed her well ahead of her time.

Mrs. Ivy Meredith of Kingston, Jamaica, WI, and late of Mount Vernon, NY, departed this life on February 26, 2020. Ivy was predeceased by her parents, Charles and Urselina Shaw of Vaughansfield, St. James; her husband, Kenneth C. Meredith; her son, James; grandsons Michael, Brian, five brothers and one sister. She is survived by her son Patrick, daughter Yvonne, and Grandson/caretaker Kenneth; several nieces, nephews, three sisters, many grandsons and granddaughters, and great grandchildren.

She will be greatly missed.
