Ausond Toyo est né à Carrefour Fleurant, l'Asile le 25 Août 1953. Il est décédé le 2 Avril 2020 à l'âge de 66 ans. Il s'est marié à 31 ans avec Gimaine Xavier et Il a laissé deux filles et un garçon, il s'agit de Anouck Toyo, Ketsie Toyo, et Jeremie Toyo. Auson a été élevé dans une famille chrétienne (catholique). Il a été scolarisé à l'âge de 3 ans dans un premier temps pour son jardin d'enfant chez madame Peyicles Fleurant ! Il a été admis à l'école communautaire de Changeux à l'âge de 5 ans chez Mr. Theobram Rejouis. Il a transféré à l'âge de 12 à l'école communale de Changeux dirigée par Mr. Prudence Charles. Il fut un bon élève, il fit toutes ses études primaires à l'Asile.

Ausond a dû quitter l'Asile le 19 Janvier 1971 pour se rendre à Port-au-Prince. Il a été reçu par sa tante madame Nicolas Surpoint. Il a continué ses études secondaires et en même temps, il a ses premiers pas dans le métier de cordonnier où il a appris à coudre des chaussures après ventes. Il eut déjà le sens des affaires où il créa sa propre entreprise.

Il a quitté Haïti en 1979 pour se rendre au Venezuela. Il y vit 2 ans. En 1981, il s'est rendu à la Guadeloupe où il y reste 3 ans. En 1984, il est allé aux USA où il a passé 36 ans. Il a travaillé dans différentes entreprises aux USA, il a eut son dernier emploi avec l'état de New York (Office of Mental Health) jusqu'à l'âge de sa retraite. Ausond a eu une enfance heureuse, il est l'aîné de son père et le benjamin de sa mère. Il a eu 5 petits frères, une petite sœur, et deux grands frères.

Il traita ses petits frères comme ses propres enfants. Il développa une relation de confiance avec eux ! Il fut un modèle à suivre, il était humble, quelqu'un qui cherche toujours à comprendre et à aider les autres.

Obituary

Ausond Toyo was born at Carrefour Fleurant, l'Asile Haiti on August 25, 1953. He died on April 2, 2020 at the age of 66.

He was married for 31 year to Gimaine Xavier together they had 2 daughters and a son, which are Anouck Toyo, Ketsie Toyo, and Jeremie Toyo.

Ausond was raised in a Christian family (Catholic). He went to daycare at the age of 3 to Mrs Peyicles Fleurant. Next, he went to primary school at the age of 5 at Community School in Changeux with principal Theobram Rejouis. At 12, he went to the Communal School in Changeux where he completed middle school.

He left his home town in 1971 to migrate to Port-au-Prince where he attended high school. He was received by his aunt Mrs. Nicolas Surpoint. While in high school, he learned to fix and make shoes and create his own business. At an early age he already had an entrepreneurship mind.

He had a happy childhood, he was the first child of his father and the third of his mother. He had 5 little brothers, one little sister and 2 older brothers. He treated his little brothers like his own son, he had a confidential relationship with his little brothers, he was humble, a great role model.

In 1979, he left Haiti to Venezuela where he lived for 2 years, then he went to Guadeloupe where he lived for 2 more years and met his wife. In 1984, he moved to New York where he lived for 36 years. He worked in many places, but his last job was with the Office of Mental Health by the State of New York up until he retired in 2015. Ausond Toyo was a Deacon at Christ is Risen Church, he loves to play the guitar and help where he can. Ausond raised his family within the Christian faith, he had love not only for his family, church family but also the Martense family. He always treated everyone with respect. Though he is gone we know he will be missed dearly; may his memories live in our hearts forever.
