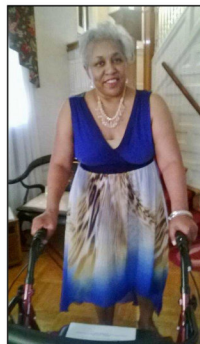
Her 35 year plus span as a food service director proves how respected in management she was. Her flare for fine dining and taste for quality came naturally.
