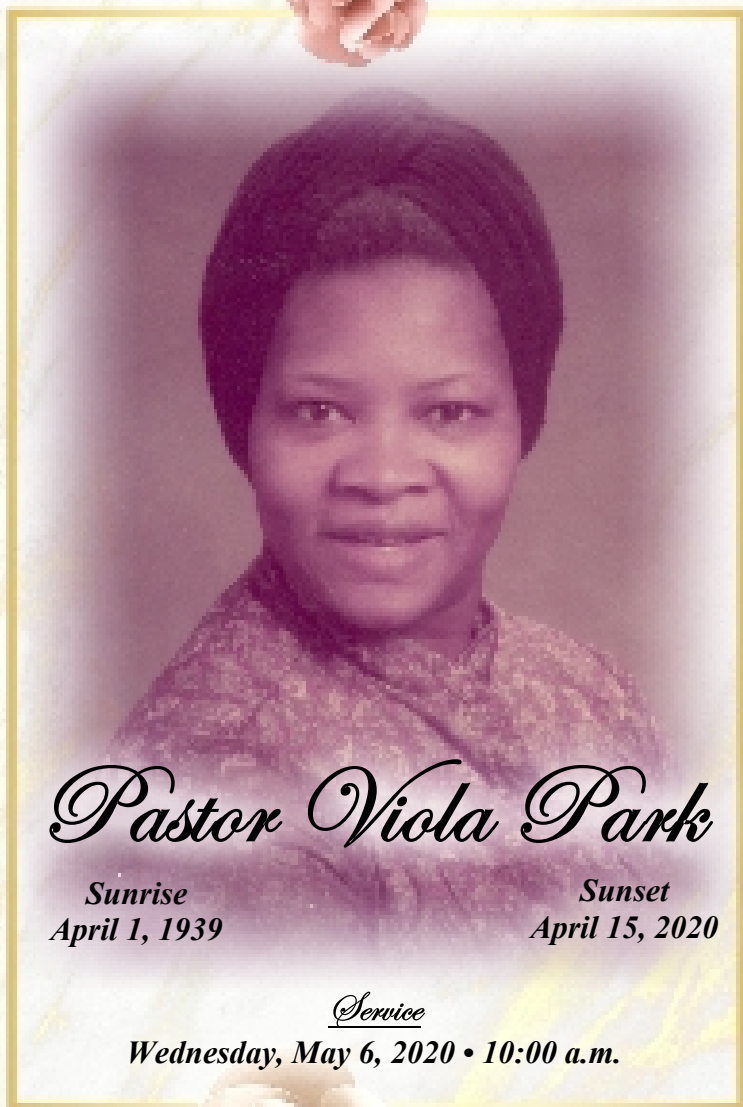

Viola L. Park affectionately called Vie by everyone was born on April 1, 1939 in Saint James Jamaica, West Indies.

She attended the local school in the Saint James Area. The Holy Trinity Church was special to her.

She later went on to learn dressmaking and she became good at it. People started to have her make various clothing for them. She did that until she received an invitation to go to England in 1962. She relocated to London for a while. She later moved to Birmingham where she worked at Dudley Road Hospital as a Nurse's Assistant for a number of years. She worked at Christian Health Care Center for many years until she retired.

In 1972 she accepted the Lord and was baptized and became a member of the United Church of God in Handsworth Birmingham, England.

In April of 1973 she migrated to Paterson, NJ. In 1975 Seashore Bible Church of God Inc was founded in Passaic, NJ and she was one of the founding members. A few years later she was ordained as a Pastor by Bishop R. Antrium. She loved the Lord and worked in the church preaching and teaching Sunday School and Adult Bible Classes.

Viola was predeceased by her mother, Gertrude Ellis.
