

<u>Obituary</u>

On Monday, April 27, 2020, the angel of god came to Bronx, NY with a handful of love and voices of silence to carry **Rev. Isaac Stucks** away from all his pain, to a place of peace and eternal life.

Rev. Isaac Stucks was born on April 10, 1926 in Columbus, Ohio, University Hospital, to the late Catherine Stucks of Jacksonville, Florida. He received his formal education in the public schools of Jacksonville, FL.

He confessed Christ at an early age and joined the St. Mark Baptist Church in Jacksonville, FL. Upon relocating to New York City, he joined the United States Army and served two years, before returning to New York City, where he met and married Mrs. Thelma Parson. Of this union two children were born.

Mr. and Mrs. Stucks joined the Mt. Bethel Baptist Church, under the late Rev. S.P. Hodge. In 1962, he was superintendent of the Sunday school, ordained as a Deacon and later ordained as a Preacher. He also served in the Mason & Eastern Star organization.

Rev. Stucks, as he was affectionately called, served as Corresponding Secretary to the United Missionary Baptist Association, Asst. Sergeant of Affairs, of the Baptist Ministers Conference of Greater New York and vicinity, Financial Secretary of the Baptist Ministers Evening Conference of Greater New York and vicinity. Then became Pastor of the Mt. Bethel Baptist Church, where he served for 15 years.

Later, he was called to the Surmount Missionary Baptist Church, where he served 2 years. But his membership and home were at Jehovah Jireh Baptist Church of Christ, under Rev. Dr. B.J. Whipper Jr.

He would let everyone know that he served as the Associate Minister of the Soundview Avenue Baptist Church, under Rev. Louis A. Holiday.

After the passing of Mrs. Thelma Stucks, he met Mrs. Mazell Jenkins in 1994 and took her hand in marriage on March 16, 1996 and lived a Loving and Peaceful life for 25 years.

Rev.
