# Obituary

Jeremiah Joshua Wallace was born on August 15th, 1923 in White Hill St Elizabeth, Jamaica, to Johnathan Wallace and Willehema Green, last survived of eight children.

Jeremiah attended White Hill Primary School. After finished his education he moved to Kingston, where he met and married his late wife Linda Eugene Wallace. The union produced eight children, seven boys, and one girl.

He worked for the Hannah Town Bakery as a Bread Salesman for many years, while operating a Restaurant and Grocery Business with his late wife. Jeremiah was always seeking an opportunity to help his relatives in Kingston to make a headstart in life. He was a disciplined man, a hard worker, loves children. Our father, otherwise known as "Papa" was a great provider. He was also very Godfearing, he would share stories with us as children about his mother, how much he loves his mother, and always loves to surprise her with something she needs. His mother has a Godly influence on his life, as a boy his mother would sometimes at nights walk through his room acting strangely, not realizing that she was praying and rejoicing in The Lord. She was indeed a woman of God.

In 1963 Papa then migrated to Birmingham England where he became a Born Again Christian. After three years and six months he returned to Jamaica. He then worked at The Purity Bakery, as a Salesman for many years, also Serv-Wel Company as a Machine Operator, where unfortunately he lost three of his fingers.

He became an ardent member of The New Testament Church of God at 65 Waltham Pk Road, Jamaica. Where he served for many years. He served faithfully in the Choir, an Accordion player, and other areas of the Church. Papa was very devoted to prayer and the word. Every Sunday morning at 5:am he would wake up all the children for Devotion. He taught us the value of prayer and the word of God. His relationship with God was very important.

In 1981 he migrated to The United States to join his late wife and family. In 1985 he became a member of The Nostrand Ave Church of God, 2201 Nostrand Ave, which is Now The BCP at 2209 Cortelyou Rd Bklyn NY, where he served as a Deacon, in the Choir, and wherever help was needed,

Papa was a sharp dresser. He was loved by many, even those who cared for him. He was A great soloist, loved to sing God's praises. One of his favorite songs "I'll Be a Friend to Jesus" He sung up until his final hour

On April 22nd, 2020, he quietly slipped home to glory. To be absent from the body is to Be present with The Lord.

He is survived by his nine children, Evelyn, Audley, Victor, Janette, Melvin, Trevor, Danielle, Sandra, Colin,<sup>33</sup> gtrandchildren,<sup>43</sup> great-grandchildren, 2 great-great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews and other relatives, and a host of friends.
