Tyease could always be found cheering from the sidelines, serving snacks to the kids and sometimes yelling at the officials. She became a surrogate mom to many of the kids on the team, who still sought her out for guidance after they grew up. Her influence with the kids will always be felt and the camaraderie she built with the other parents will be missed by all.

Tyease was a nurturer throughout her life. Last year she took time off her job to take care of her mother in Alabama with no hesitation. That's the kind of person she was... always helping others. She will truly be missed.

Tyease had a special bond with her daughter, R'Kaiya. She was her biggest cheerleader and strongest protector. They had a bond that could not be defined and was absolute. Their bond did not have any limitations. They shared a love that can never truly be broken.
