# *I'm Free*

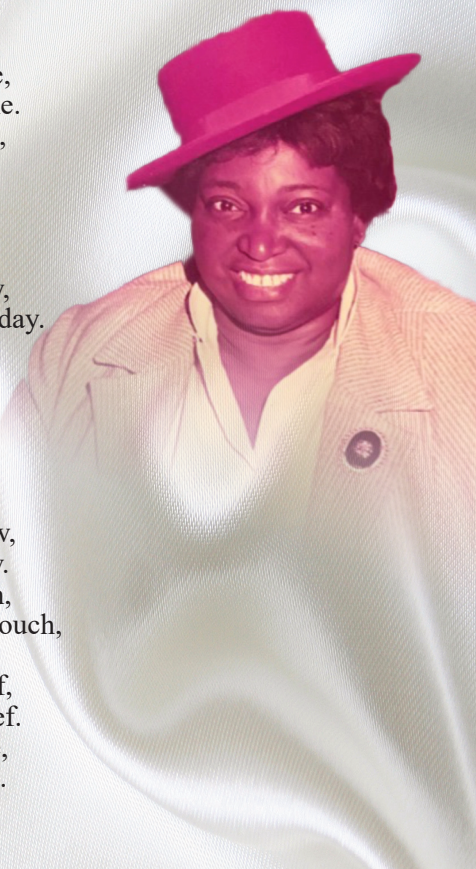
Don't grieve for me, for now I'm free,
