

Obituary

As time progressed, and due to health concerns, she was moved to a nursing facility (Beth Abraham Center for Rehabilitation & Nursing) where she received 24 hours care and family access.

Mrs. Isoline was pre-deceased by her husband Cecil Bernard and their children Pearline and Joseph. She leaves behind to continue her legacy to seven daughters and one son: Stella Chin (Husband Everard);Icilida Rose (Husband Nathaniel); Hazel Eubanks (Husband Casell);Venus Francis (Husband Kenneth); Phyllis Lewis (Late Husband Sylburn); Rupert Bernard (Wife Novelette); Teslyn Bernard (Joe's wife); Marion Graham(Husband Gilcrest); Evelyn Bernard and was blessed with 47 grandchildren and a 85 great grandchildren.
