Her favorite fruits was watermelon, strawberries, and grapes. Kamiyah loved watching Ryan Toy Review and famous tube kids on YouTube. She enjoyed playing with her LOL Dolls and all her Ryan toys she had made a few of us purchase, but most importantly she loved spending time and having fun with her siblings. She liked doing nails and makeup with Kaliyah, playing and running through the house with her guy's (Kahseme and Kalany), and hide and seek with all of her siblings and her cousins when they came over. The most we remember and still say up to today is all Kamiyah's little quotes, like when mom talk to the kids and they didn't listen she will reinforce by saying, “guy's what did mommy say?” or when mommy call someone and they did come to her Kamiyah will call them and say, “you didn't hear mommy call you? Get over here now, now”. She always wanted to beat someone's bum bum (her words) and when they didn't let her she would come tell mom or dad to do it for her. Kamiyah always wanted to make it to school on time rushing dad so that she can help the teacher's take down the chairs and greet her classmates as they come in. She liked making mom take her to the store almost everyday after school to get her cotton candy and on the way back from the store to the house we had to skip to her Lou all the way to the building. She had to wait until 5:30 for her guy's (her siblings) to come from after school but everyday she will remind them how much she loved them because they made her laugh. Kamiyah had a big impact on a lot of people lives and I know everyone sitting her today has a fun or great memory of her.

Kamiyah was predeceased by her Grandparents Jaqueline Pope, and George Bryson. 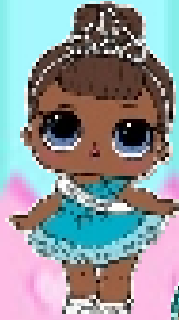
