### Obituary

We are here today to celebrate the life of **Albert Davis Jr**, who peacefully ascended to be with the Lord on Tuesday, June 30, 2020. He was 76 years old.

Albert was born on September 20,1943 to proud parents, Albert Sr. and Lina R. Davis (Blackburn) in Gorgas Hospital, located in Panama City, Panama, also known as the Canal Zone. He, his parents and his sister Alberta lived together in Paraiso, Panama, and then relocated to Rio Abaho in 1955. He attended Republica Haiti primary school there, and made a host of friends, including Diana T. George which he met at the budding age of 15. She would later become the love of his life.

In 1960, he then immigrated to the United States to live with his father, and stepmother, Iris Davis. He resided in Brooklyn, where he attended George Wingate HS. He graduated in 1964 at the age of 19. Immediately upon graduating, Albert then decided to enlist in the United States Air Force, in which he served 4 complete years. During that time, he was then joined by lovely Diana in 1964 when she had also come from Panama to live in the States.

On December 18, 1965, Albert and Diana decided to join hands in holy matrimony at the Methodist Baptist Church in Brooklyn. They created a life for themselves, and from this union, two beautiful children were conceived, Albert III and 10 yrs later, Denise Melinda. They lived in Brooklyn as Albert worked for Merrill Lynch and then moved on to establish a career as a meter reader and then customer service supervisor at Con Edison Utility Company.

Albert Jr. was a vivacious, fun loving person, who was full of life and vitality. He possessed a smooth crooner's voice, which enabled him to emulate some of his favorite singers growing up, like Frank Sinatra and Elvis Presley. He sang in several different groups with friends and his Brother in Law, Lloyd George Jr. He loved to dance, and he was a natural born entertainer. In fact, he loved dancing so much that he and his sister gave dance classes in Panama, where they taught others how to Salsa, and dance crazes of the rock and roll era.

Albert loved to watch cartoons and westerns when he had the chance. He loved the Yankees, especially when Panama's own Mariano Rivera was on the plate.

Music was an integral part of the Davis household. He spent much time with his son in the early years encouraging him to perfect his love of the guitar. He also was very supportive of his daughter's natural singing ability. Albert always encouraged his children to tap into their creative abilities that came innately to him.

He had a captivating smile that could light up a room, and a magnetic personality that sometimes could enter that room before he did. Albert was the perpetual life of the party. He was a STAR. He loved his family and close friends dearly and kept each and every one close to his heart.

Albert decided he wanted to start a new chapter later on in life by moving to Florida, and then Massachusetts for a change of pace. He then resorted to living in Florida because of the warm weather which reminded him so much of home. He felt it was a better place for him, and there is where he remained to live out the rest of the days.

Albert Jr. was preceded in death by his mother Lina, his stepmother, Iris, brother in law, Lloyd George Jr and his nephew, Roberto A. Jemmot.

His is survived by his wife, Diana, his children Albert III and Denise Melinda, grandchildren Donovan J. Davis and Jessica L. Davis, great grandchildren Donovan Jr. and Elina Dee, sister Alberta E. Brathwaite and Brother in Law, Amos Brathwaite, brother Wayne Davis, father Albert Davis Sr, and wife, Bernice Davis.

He leaves behind nieces, Tesha E. Jemmot and Tasha Y. Preudhomme, a host of loving cousins, and dear friends.
