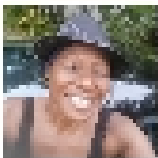
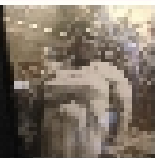
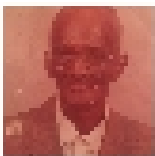
She was educated in the public schools in Georgia. She also attended Passaic High School Passaic

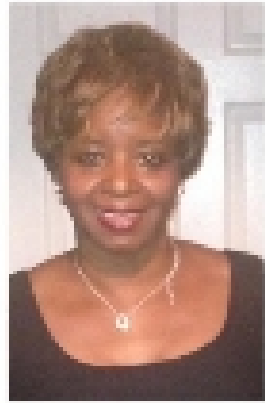
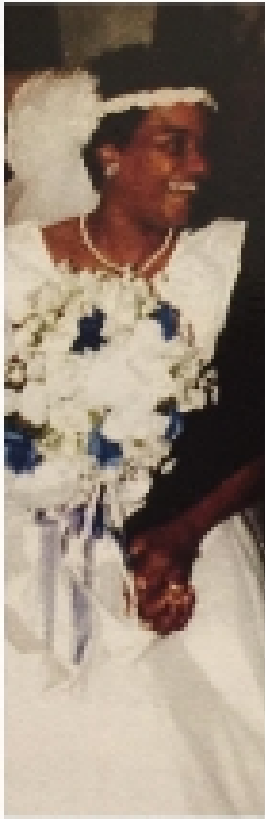
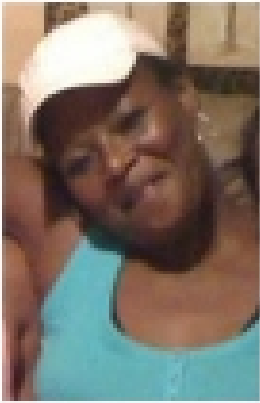
