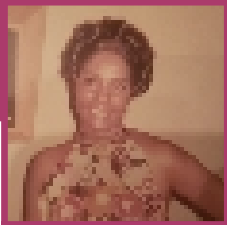
Obituary



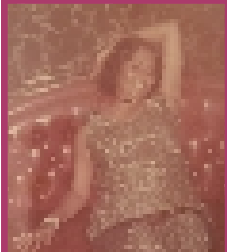
