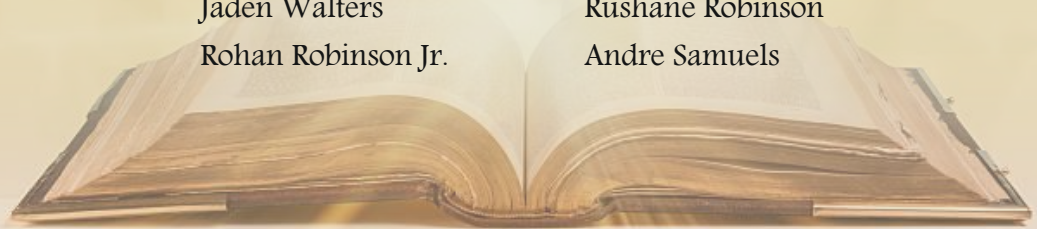

Obituary

Norma Jean Robinson was born on August 10, 1944, to the late Ernest Brown and Esmie Morrison in Mayday, Manchester, Jamaica, West Indies. Norma was the first of five children and in her early years attended Old England All-Age School. After completing her secondary education, she learned how to professionally sew at the age of 16 under the direction of Mrs. Doris Thompson, one of the leading seamstresses in the community. She used her talents to become a prominent seamstress during her adult years in Manchester while maintaining her household. In 1970, Norma Jean married James Ruddy Robinson, who preceded her in death in January 2015. This union produced eight children; Frank, Lorna, Donnette, Petal, Marie, Rohan, Nadine, and Jason. Norma, Ruddy and 7 of her family members emigrated to Peekskill, New York in February 1988. Norma had a host of jobs before gaining long term employment at Hudson Valley Hospital as a dietary aide for over 20 years. Following her retirement in 2008, she returned back home to George's Valley.

Norma was a lover of gardening her flowers, cooking her large family meals and banking her partner. She could often be heard describing her blooming roses and lilies. She will most definitely be remembered for having an unfiltered soul like no other. She was a jovial, kind and loving Individual who was a mother and mentor to many. Norma was the matriarch of her family and friends and was an invaluable spirit in her hometowns of Georges Valley, Jamaica and Peekskill, New York. As children, most of us could not comprehend or fully recognize the extent of the protectiveness, guidance and love Norma had for us. As we look back through older eyes and wiser hearts, we are better able to understand and greatly appreciate the love and loyalty she had for us. After a long and courageous battle with seizures, Norma departed this life on August 29, 2020 at Northern Westchester Restorative Nursing Facility.

Norma leaves to cherish her memory her brothers, Oswald and Errol and sisters Doreen, Lynette and Patricia. Her legacy is survived by her four maternal children Lorna, Petal, Rohan and Jason as well as Frank, Donnette, Marie and Nadine, 26 grandchildren, a host of great grandchildren as well as a host of other dear relatives and supportive friends.
