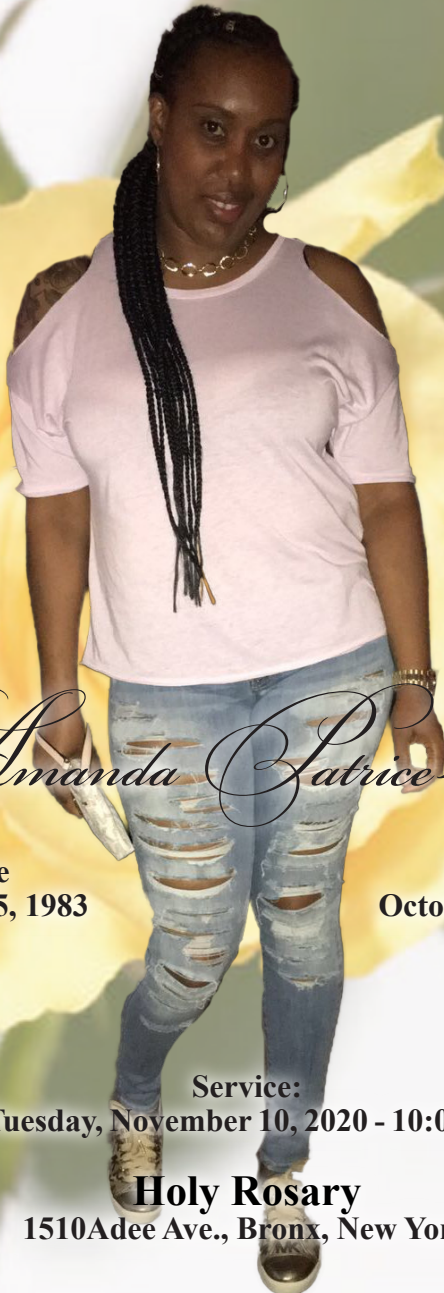

Obituary

Amanda Patrice-Guiste was born on November 25th 1983 to Ryan Patrice and Kathleen Jacob (deceased) in the village of Bense in the Commonwealth of Dominica.
