Ann attended P.S. 57, JHS 117, and Benjamin Franklin High School where she graduated in 1963. She was a cheerleader and active in numerous extracurricular clubs.

While in high school she met her future husband, Joseph E. Rhames, Sr. He was a standout athlete and point guard on the basketball team. They married in June of 1967 and that union resulted in a son, Joseph E. Rhames, Jr., the following year. She would continue her academic career at Hunter College, where she received a B.A. in Education in 1977. Years later she received her Master's at the New School for Social Research, specializing in Social Work.

She worked as a clerk at Mutual Life Insurance Company immediately after high school and a few years later as a cashier in Gimbels, before settling into a career as a Respiratory Therapist. She spent most of her career at Bronx Lebanon and Lenox Hill Hospital and freelanced at many hospital and nursing facilities throughout the tri-state area. During her years at Bronx Lebanon, she took great care of her niece, Lynecia Williams, every time she was admitted into the hospital.

Besides being a supportive family member, her great love was travel. She cruised in the Caribbean, the west coast, and the south pacific. She especially enjoyed dressing for the formal dinners and could tell you which cruise lines had the best meals and buffets. Shrimp and lobster were particular favorites. She touched on a majority of the seven continents in her travels: Europe, Africa, North America and Australia. She had a particular love of Barbados, in the Caribbean, where she developed close personal ties that endured her entire life.

She was active in her High School Alumni Association where she rekindled many old friendships after retirement. A particular highlight was helping organize the annual Alumanni Barbeque every August in William Jefferson Park.
