Alton "Bagga" Saunders was born on May 11, 1952 in Westmoreland, Jamaica, to the late Thelma Bushay and John Saunders. Alton was the seventh of ten children and was known as one of the mischievous boys that would always be seen hanging off from the back of a truck. Alton attended New Works School, with his siblings, and was later sent to gain mechanic skills in the Maxfield Area of Kingston. Alton's love for trucks could not be satisfied as he later became a driver of a truck before leaving Jamaica in 1980 and again shortly after migrating to New York in 1981. Before leaving Jamaica, Alton married his sweetheart, Joan also known as Nola. A year after arriving in the United States, Alton, now known as "Bagga" among his peers because he often looked tired with bags under his eyes, started his first business and opened a tire repair shop on White Plains Road, Bronx which became a popular hang out spot for Jamaicans living close by. Bagga would later relocate his tire repair shop to Boston Road and would spend most of his life running his business.

Bagga loved to socialize and share his cooking with those in need and this was evident in his everyday life. He had a deep and undeniable laugh that could be heard and recognized by those who knew him. He was able to fuse his passions with his business and it was therefore not strange to pass by the 'Tire Shop' and be greeted by the familiar scent of jerk chicken, music playing and men socializing loudly.

Unfortunately, Alton battled with cancer twice, and even then continued to maintain his passions. During his second bout of cancer, though the demands of surgery and treatment proved to be too much for him, he never stopped making jokes, laughing, and checking in with friends and family. On Saturday, December 12, 2020, Alton departed this life to go and rest in the loving arms of the Father.

Alton is survived to cherish his memory by his second wife Veronica, four sisters Lovena, Ivy, Dotty and Mavis; four brothers Newton, Verton, Vincent and Clifton, his four children; Ryan, Bryan, Mitsy, Jalani, seven grandkids and a host of nieces, nephews and friends.
