

Henry Burnside passed at Harlem Hospital in New York, New York due to complications of heart problems on Monday, January 25th at 3:37 a.m. He was 62 years old.

Henry Burnside was born on November 5, 1958 in New York, New York to his parents, Robert and Lula Mae Burnside, who moved from the south to New York City in the 40s. Henry attended Brandeis High School in Manhattan and received his Associate Degree in Business Administration from Interboro Institute in 1992.
