# Obituary

On Friday, February 12th, 2021, God called one of his son's home. Lloyd Hilton Brutus, was born on January 15th , 1934 to the late Doris Ameila Brutus-Success and Benjamin Brutus of Guyana, South America. Lloyd was the fourth of sixteen children, 10 of who preceded him in death.

Lloyd obtained his primary and higher education at Scott School and All Saint Anglican School. Upon successfully completing his academic pursuit, Lloyd obtained employment as a Prison Warden and a Male Attendant at Canji Mental Health Hospital in New Amsterdam, Berbice. He later relocated to Georgetown where he was employed by Bookers Ltd, and later Degar Brothers Inc.

During his early years, Lloyd developed a passion for soccer. He became an active soccer player and always boasted of himself as being a skillful and well rounded, player. He played all positions, but was at his best as a striker/goal scorer. He enjoyed holding conversations with his son-in-law, who is also an ardent soccer player. He never hesitated to remind him of his great skills. He would say, "Boy I was really good. I was a good striker. I enjoyed the game. I played with some of the best players in my time; not only in Guyana but also in the Caribbean." He expressed that he enjoyed watching the game on television. The English Premier League was his favorite. In his words, "They're very good and exciting to watch."



As Lloyd continued his journey of life, he met and later was united in holy matrimony to Rosetta Brutus. This union produced two beautiful daughters. Rosetta preceded her husband in death.

In 1968, Lloyd immigrated to New York in search of a new horizon. He later met and married his bride, Olivia Brutus, and two sons was added to this union. Throughout his years in New York, he was employed with several corporations, most notably, Morning Side Nursing Home for 44 years. During his tenure at Morning Side, he served as a Unit Manager and 1199 Union Representative. Lloyd demonstrated commitment, dedication and proficiency. He was never tardy and always punctual.

Lloyd loved life and was full of excitement. He enjoyed traveling and dancing. He later developed a passion for bowling. He faithfully bowled on a weekly basis, entering and won many championship games. Lloyd's passion for bowling led him to be a recruiter for the game. Among his recruiters are his two sons, Lloyd Jr and Lenny; and his bride Olivia. Monday nights was family bowling night for Lloyd and his family. He and his sons bowled against his wife's team. On many Monday night they engaged in heated battles against each other's team.

Lloyd will be missed for his humor and infectious laughter. He now joins his love ones preceding his death, his parents, Doris Leitch and Benjamin Brutus; Daughter: Denise Brutus; Grand Daughter: Vanessa Collins; Sisters: Verona Brutus, Gladys Leitch, Edna Joe, Yvonne Alexander; Brothers: James Brutus, Vincent Leitch, Rickford Leitch, Albert Leitch & Nevil Campbell.
