

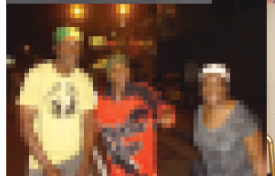

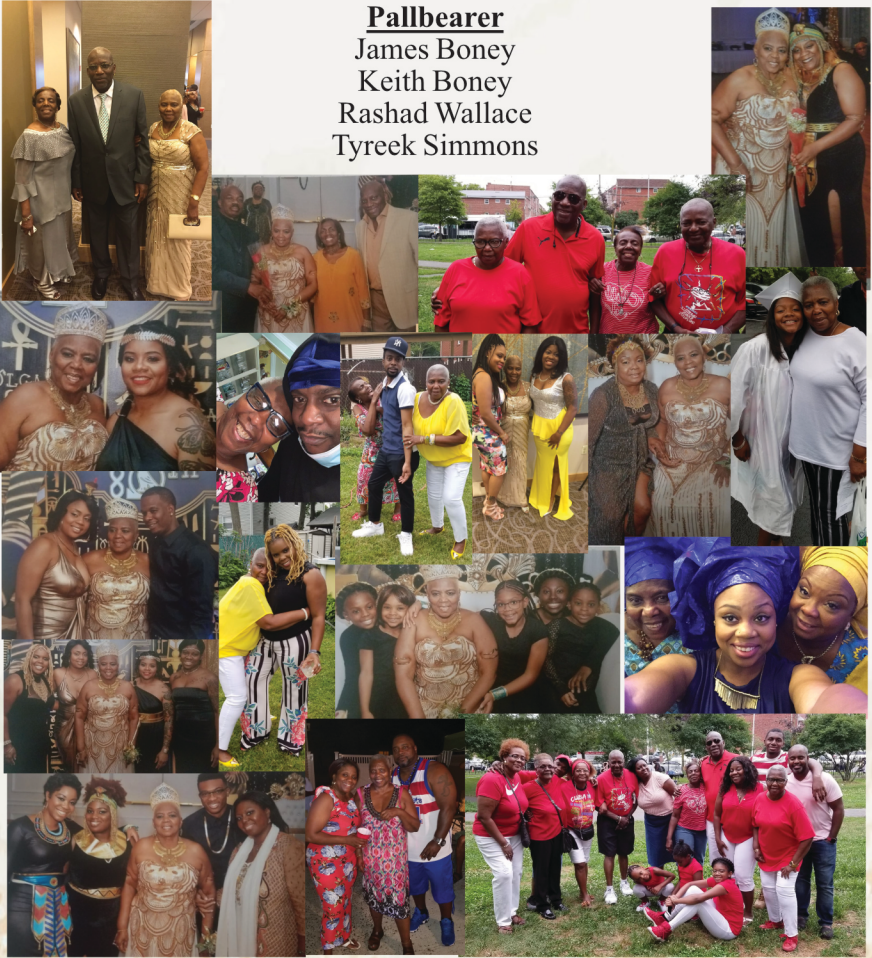


I'll Fly Away
