Obituary

Born April 11, 1929 to parents James and Hilda Garvey, **Patricia** was one of eight siblings. Her two brothers, James Garvey and Douglas Garvey (Deceased); Her five sisters: Hazel Singleton, Cloretta Garvey, Francis Layne, Sheila Springer (all of whom are deceased) and Peggy Rollins, her only living sibling. She had many friends and enjoyed attending dances on the weekends. She always spoke fondly of her time in England.

In 1969, Patricia journeyed to The United States with her son Alan. She moved to The Bronx, where she landed a job with Montefiore Hospital. Patricia lived a half block from her job, allowing her to walk to work every day. Patricia loved nursing. Although she started out as a floor nurse she moved to the ophthalmology department where she spent the majority of her 27 year career, and where she formed so many life-long friendships. Patricia retired in 1997 and spent her retirement travelling with family and attending senior activities at the Montefiore Mosholu Senior center. Patricia was an active member of Epiphany Lutheran church, volunteering in the thrift shop and other community events. She remained a member for many years up until her death.

Patricia was very generous, regularly supporting charities, her church and family. She was extremely proud of her son Alan, her grandchildren Nathaniel, Dr. Dara Jackson and Tuere Jackson whom she loved very much.

Patricia is survived by her sister Peggy; her son Alan; her daughter-in-law Jhanice; her grandchildren Nathaniel, Dara, Tuere; nieces and nephews and countless friends. Patricia will be truly missed by all.
