OBITUARY

Calvin Daniels was born in Kingston Jamaica on November-27-1938. He departed this life on March-5-2021 at the age of 82 in his own home surrounded by his wife and son. He was 1 of 9 children and was the 1st born of twins to Floribell and Joseph Daniels.

He was educated in Kingston and completed his training at St. Andrews Technical Institute where he mastered his trade in metal manufacturing and tooling.

Calvin loved the lord and served as an alter boy in his youth in Jamaica. He continued to be an active member in his church through the years at St Augustine's, Home Street Church, and here at St. Luke's Episcopal church.

Calvin was a consistent and hard-working man. He worked for 25 years at Metal Box Co. in Jamaica and another 20 years at Dayton Industries after migrating to America. He was a very much-loved employee and co-worker there as he grew in his career over the years. His friends and others affectionately called him "Danny Boy".

He had an accident at the factory while performing maintenance on a die casting machine, where he damaged his left hand badly losing a finger and causing damage to the palm of his hand. He made a full recovery and returned to work as soon as he was able to. His friends at work from that day on gave him the nickname of "Gold Finger".

Calvin was a very funny person and he could see the humor in any situation no matter how dark the circumstances may seem. He always had a calming affect and kept his head on straight while others may panic. He was able to accept things for what they were and always continued to move forward with a clear mind and a full heart. When someone passed away he would always say "The lord giveth and the lord taketh away, blessed be the name of the Lord".

In 1970 Calvin married the love of his life Sonia Lawrence. Their union produced one child Lawrence Daniels who thoughtfully carries both of their family names with him. Lawrence is married to his wife Jennifer Daniels and they have 3 children: Gianni Daniels, Lauren Daniels, and Kendric Daniels. Calvin adored his grand children and they loved him back very much. It made him so happy to see that the next generation was on the right path. Anyone who had the pleasure of knowing him had nothing but good things to say. He did all that was expected of him and more as a husband, father, grandfather, brother, employee, and child of God.
