On Wednesday February 24, 2021 Cassandra Hilary Rowe of Bronx, N.Y at the age of 53 years old departed this earthly life.

Cassandra Hilary Rowe was born was born on September 8.1967 in Portland Jamaica W.I. to Perdicia McMurrin and the late Leabert Rowe. The second of 8 children she was raised she attended Port Antonio high school.

She welcomed daughter Camara and soon after daughter Shenika and as a single mother did everything within her powers in caring for and raising her children. She often reminisced on how difficult her life was growing up and as an adult and as a result she would make sure her children never experienced what she had to go through and regardless of her struggles was always thankful, always felt blessed and more so with the birth of her grandson Justin who she loved more than life itself. Later in life she married her longtime companion Lawrence Dubre.

In the mid 2000's she migrated to the United States and continued with the same strengths. She worked for different companies including SUS until her untimely death. She loved her job and enjoyed providing care to the individuals whom she rendered care to.

To truly describe her, all adjectives would be an understatement. Cassandra loved to laugh quite loudly and long at times; it was entertaining. She also enjoyed dancing and was always the first to start dancing when she heard music she liked and it usually bringing smiles to the people around her. She was also sometimes misunderstood as she was never one to shy away from the truth, sugarcoat things or beat around the bush. No matter who you were, she would express her feelings, regardless of whether you liked what she had to say or not. If you were wrong, she would let you know even at the expense of your disliking her. She was a kind, supportive, dedicated, and caring person and willing to lend a hand or render advice if needed and a better friend one would not need. Her favorite line" money can never come between me and anyone" and she lived her life just like that.

She loved her country, the food, the people, and the customs. Her dream was to go home to her beloved country. In her own words, "the food, the breeze, the people, everything is just better", she would always say, and that she could never get used to living in a foreign country because it is just not the same.

Cassandra was very private and regardless of her struggles, she put her best foot forward even during her illness. When the outlook was grim, to the very end she protected the ones who loved her the most because she did not want to bother anyone.

Cassandra survived by her mother Perdicia McMurrin of Portland Jamaica W.I., husband Lawrence Dubre, daughters Camara McCarty and Shenika Taylor, grandson Justin Brown, 3 sisters, 4 brothers and a host of other close relatives and friends.
