Obituary

Ena Kerr was born to parents Georgiana Whitter and Adolphus Kerr On June 14, 1931, in Richmond district, Hanover, Jamaica West Indies. Sadly, she lost her father at the tender age of two but was raised by her stepfather, Walter Sanderson. She was the eldest of 3 children. The youngest, a brother, predeceased her in 2019.

She received her elementary education at the Riverside primary school, and then went on to sewing school. She made her living as a Seamstress, catering for clients in the district, especially for the children who needed school uniforms

In her early life she moved to Kingston, Jamaica with her future husband Kenneth Waite. She spent most of her young adult life in Kingston, hence 5 of her 6 children were born there. While living in Kingston she worked as a Seamstress and a Domestic to help support her family.

In 1969, Ena returned to the parish of Hanover with her family and was introduced to the Seventh day Adventist message by her brother -in -law and started attending the Success Seventh Day Adventist church. In 1975, she was baptized in the Hopewell Seventh Day Adventist church where she became an active member. She served as a Deaconess for many years and was also involved in the Lay Activates department (Now Personal Ministry) and Dorcas department (now Community Services department).

In 1991, Ena and her husband Kenneth migrated to the USA. She resided in the Bronx with her daughter and helped to babysit her grandchildren. She traveled back and forth to Jamaica every year, where she spent the winter months. she also travelled back and forth to Miami often to be with her son's family.

In New York, she visited several Adventist churches, until she transferred her membership to the Shalom SDA Church. She enjoyed attending Shalom Church and would spend the entire sabbath there each week when she was here in New York. She was an avid reader, her favorite books ranged from the Bible, religious books and even fairy tales. She also loved to walk, and instead of taking the bus she would walk to her destinations. Her favorite hymn was 'Blessed Assurance' and her favorite scripture was Psalm 46.

Ena was blessed with good health for many years, except for arthritis, and glaucoma that slowly left her blind. She was never hospitalized for anything serious until November 2020, when she was diagnosed with heart failure. Her condition rapidly deteriorated until she quietly slept away in the early hours of February 24, 2021. She is predeceased by her daughter Pauline Waite, and her great granddaughter Aniyah Daley.

Left to mourn her loss are, her husband Kenneth Waite; sister Florence Campbell; Daughters Laura Clarke, Joan Waite, Sharon Lawrence; sons Ransford Waite, and Astley Waite; sons-in-law Hector Clarke and Aaron Lawrence; daughter -in-law Ronetta Waite; nineteen grandchildren, 23 great grandchildren and one great, great grandchild, plus a host of other family, and friends.

May her soul rest in peace until that great resurrection day when the dead in Christ shall rise first, and those that are alive will be caught up, and we shall be re-united. Let us all be prepared for that day.
