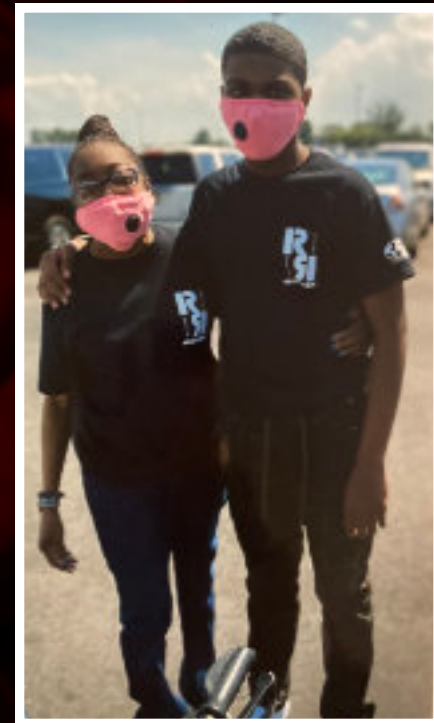






# *God's Garden*
