The Life and Times of Aaron Anderson

Aaron Anderson was born on January 23, 1929 at the City Hospital in Newark, NJ. He was the 3rd child of the late Samuel and Jessie Anderson. He attended Monmouth Street Elementary School and South Side High School in Newark, NJ. During those years, he loved to frequent the Court Street Y.M.C.A.

After graduating high school, Aaron joined the army, went to Korea and served in the Army Artillery Unit #466 from 1951- 1953. While there, he became a radio operator. He was honorably discharged in 1953. He then went to school under the GI Bill at the Manhattan Institute for Upholstering and Interior Decorating.

In 1962, Aaron married the love of his life, Sadie Boswell. They were married for forty-four wonderful years until her death on August 7, 2006. For the past 60 years, Aaron had been a member of The Queen of Angels Church in Newark, NJ until they closed their doors in 2010. During his membership there, he was the chairman of the Queen of Angels Credit Union for 25 years. After the closing of Queen of Angels Church, Aaron transferred his membership to Blessed Sacrament Church in Newark, NJ. He also worked at Macy's in Newark selling men's clothing for twenty years. He retired from Macy's in 1991.

Aaron was predeceased by his brother, Edward Anderson and sister, Louise Smith. He is survived by his nephew, Rodney Bernard (Brenda).
