Reflections of Life

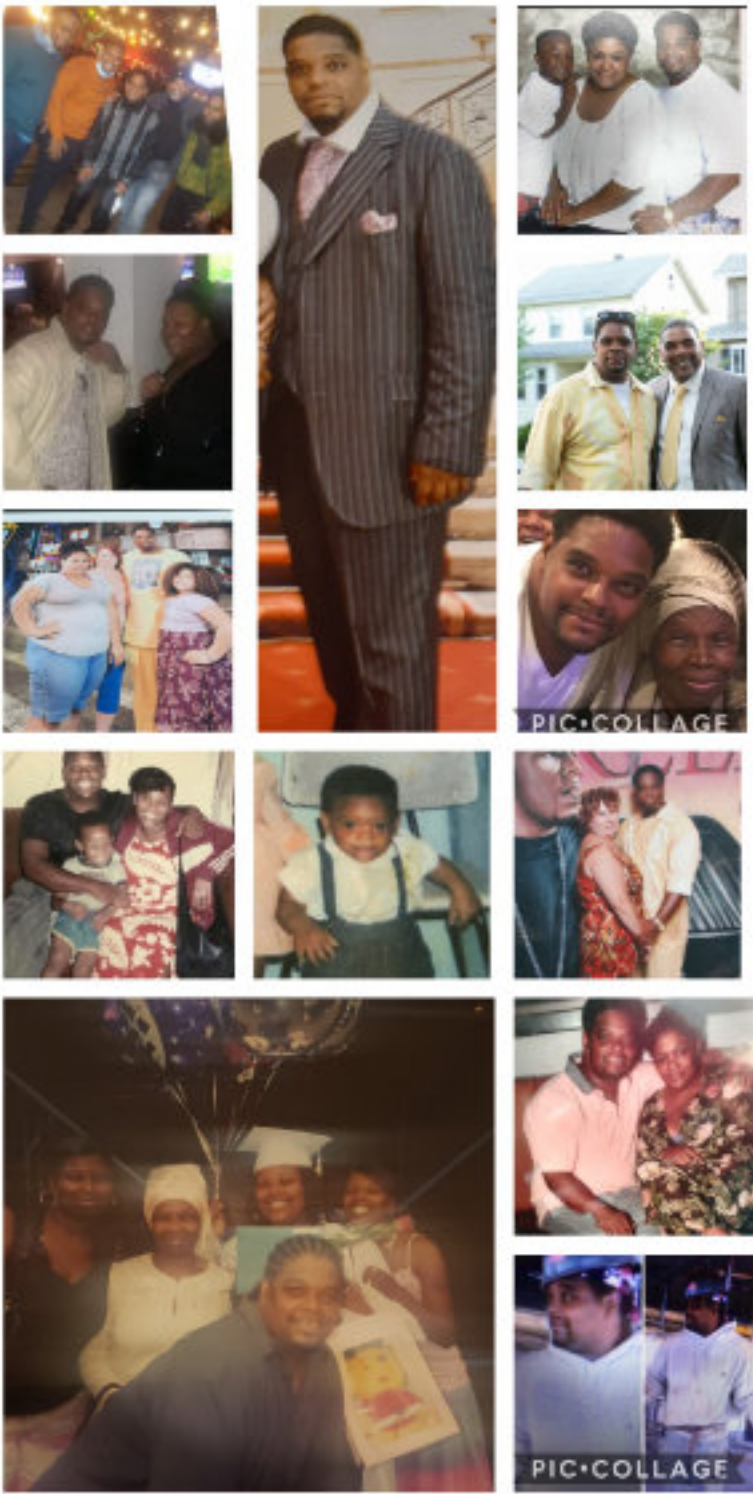
