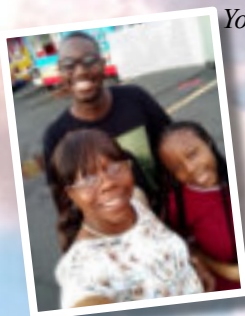
*She was preceded in death by her mother, Bobby; father, David; brother, Ryan; uncle, Clyde; and cousin, Divine.*

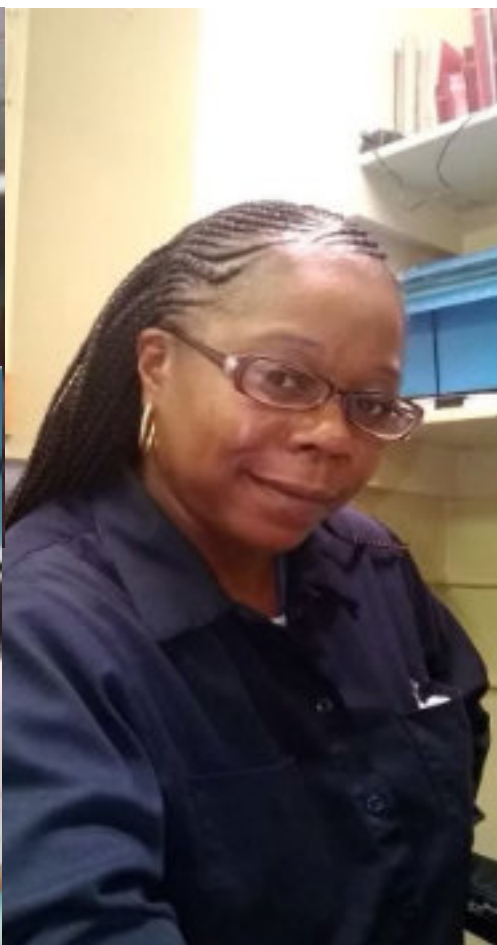

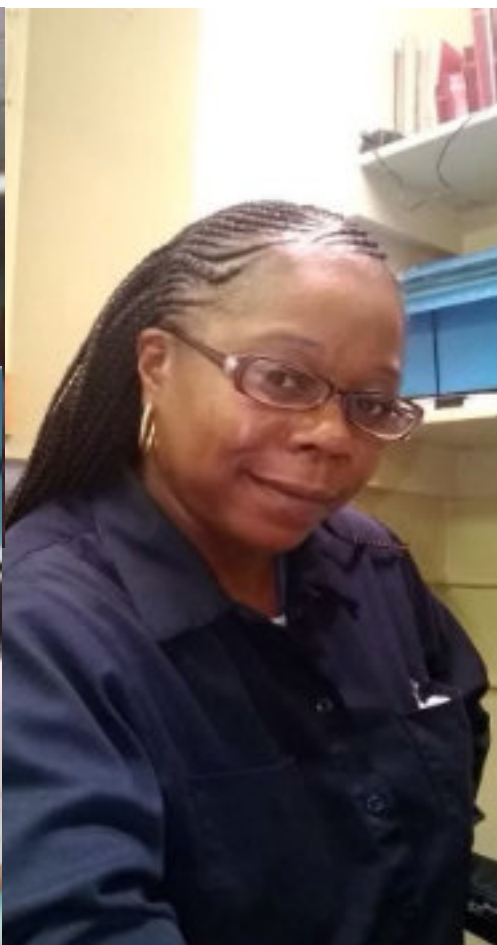
