Samuel Raymond Mitchell Jr. was preceded in death by his son Conan Davis, his parents Viola and Samuel Raymond Mitchell Sr. Two brothers Jihad and Niam Shabazz, sister Linda Harris.

Samuel departed this life on Friday April 23, 2021 at the age of 68.
