Her jokes always flowed naturally, there was not a dull moment around her. She and her mother Gwendolyn Smith were inseparable, often talking and laughing like best friends.

Winsome Chin died Tuesday, April 29, 2021 in Lawrence Hospital in Bronxville NY from complications of contracting COVID-19. She was in the hospital for 3 months and fought extremely hard to live. She never gave up on life and her spirit will live on through her family.
