Obituary

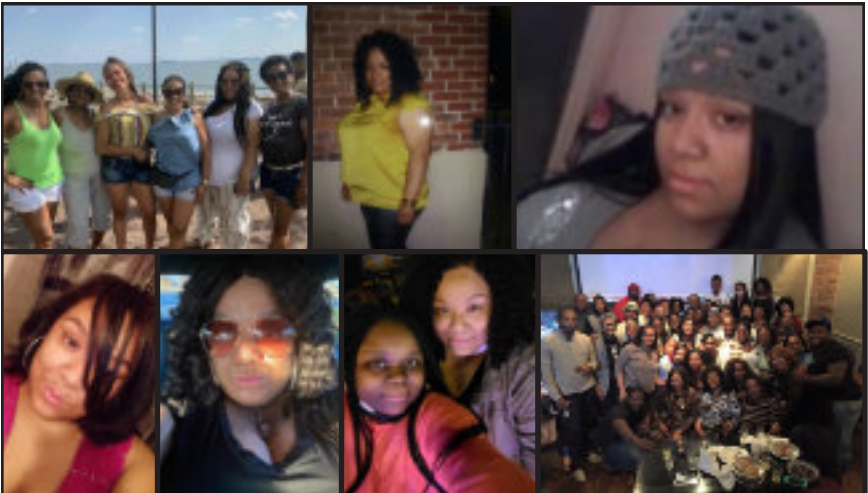

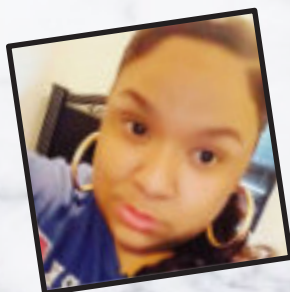
