OBITUARY

Kenneth Wilson Waite was born to parents Melbourne Waite and Doris Anderson on March 20, 1933 in Maroon Town, St James Jamaica. He was the second of 13 children,10 from his paternal side, plus another sister from his maternal side. However, he was predeceased by four of his siblings.

Kenneth only received an elementary education, but he had a very busy and full life. He left his father's home at an early age, and traveled all over Jamaica. Most of his young adult life was spent in Kingston Jamaica with his wife and children. He worked as a baker for a while and then went into the wood cutting business, something which he loved, and it became his main source of income. Eventually he started his own wood cutting business in the parish of St. James until he was forced to retire due to illness and advance age. Kenneth also entered into a stone cutting business briefly with his older brother in 1969 in the parish of Hanover resulting in the relocation of his family to that parish.

He migrated to the Bronx, New York in 1991 together with his wife where he lived with his daughter. However, Kenneth never really liked New York, so he traveled back and forth to Jamaica frequently, and continued his wood cutting business when he was there.

Kenneth was exposed to the Adventist church as a child, because his father and stepmother were seventh day Adventist. There was nothing much one could teach him about the Bible that he was not aware of, but he was never baptized until 2015 when he finally accepted Christ as his personal Savior at a Tent meeting in Montego Bay, Jamaica. He was baptized at the age of 82, and became a member of the Lilliput SDA church.

Kenneth was mild mannered, slow to anger, and friendly. He loved playing dominoes and card games with his friends, he loved watching TV, and loved to watch old movies, I think his favorite was the "Ten Commandments", he was very excited when that movie came on during the recent Easter weekend. He also had a great interest in the politics of the USA and Jamaica.

After his retirement and baptism, he didn't attend church regularly in New York especially since he was home bound, but he enjoyed listening to records and DVDs of the Heritage and Gaiter singers. He loved watching 3abn, especially on Sabbaths.

Kenneth had quite a few health issues, but his condition was stable, therefore his passing at this time was unexpected, after a short stay in the hospital.

Left to cherish his memory are his nine siblings, brothers- Victor, Owen, Everton, sisters – Phyllis, Beryl, Jean, Shirley, Ottey and Clover. Nine children, 34 grandchildren, 34 great grandchildren and two great grandchildren, plus a host of nieces, nephews, and other family and friends. He was predeceased by his wife Ena Waite, a son, a daughter and a great granddaughter.

May his soul rest in peace, until that great getting up morning when the dead in Christ will rise first, and those that are alive will be caught up to meet him.
