Obituary

After passing the common entrance exam he was accepted to attend Kingston College High School, one of the top high schools in Jamaica.

Following his time at Kingston College, Perriez and his family migrated to the United States in 1990. After arriving in the US and settling in the Bronx, Perriez attended Harry S. Truman High School where he graduated and was awarded a high school diploma.

Even back home, from a very tender age, Perriez had great interest in animals. At many different points in time he took care of dogs, kittens, chickens, fish, hamsters, turtles and many other animals. He brought that passion with him to the United States. Because of this, his next major step towards his education was to attend Laguardia Community College in Queens, NY. Here he studied to become a Veterinary Technician. He attended the college until he entered the real world and took advantage of the veterinary skills acquired. Perriez got a job at the North Shore Animal League in Port Washington, NY in 1997 where he spent several years working as a Veterinary Technician until 2011. During his time working at the North Shore Animal League, Perriez worked part time at several other places such as the Fifth Avenue Veterinary Specialist in New York, NY and Petmed Animal Hospital in Mamaroneck, NY. After moving from New York to Georgia, Perriez continued to work with animals at Blue Pearl Animal Hospital.

As a warm-hearted, kind and giving individual, Perriez' compassion for life and others extended beyond animals to his nieces and nephews. He maintained his relationships with them as he enjoyed planning trips to visit them in different states and encouraging them to visit him.

For months, Perriez' strength and will persisted during his unconscious state. Although he made small steps towards recovery, Perriez passed away on May 11, 2021. He will be missed by numerous family members, friends, cousins, aunts, nieces, nephews, neighbors, coworkers and many others. Perriez is survived by his mother, Iona; father, Norvis; Brothers, Pete and Patrick; sister Patricia; son Tristan; and fiance Tiffany.


