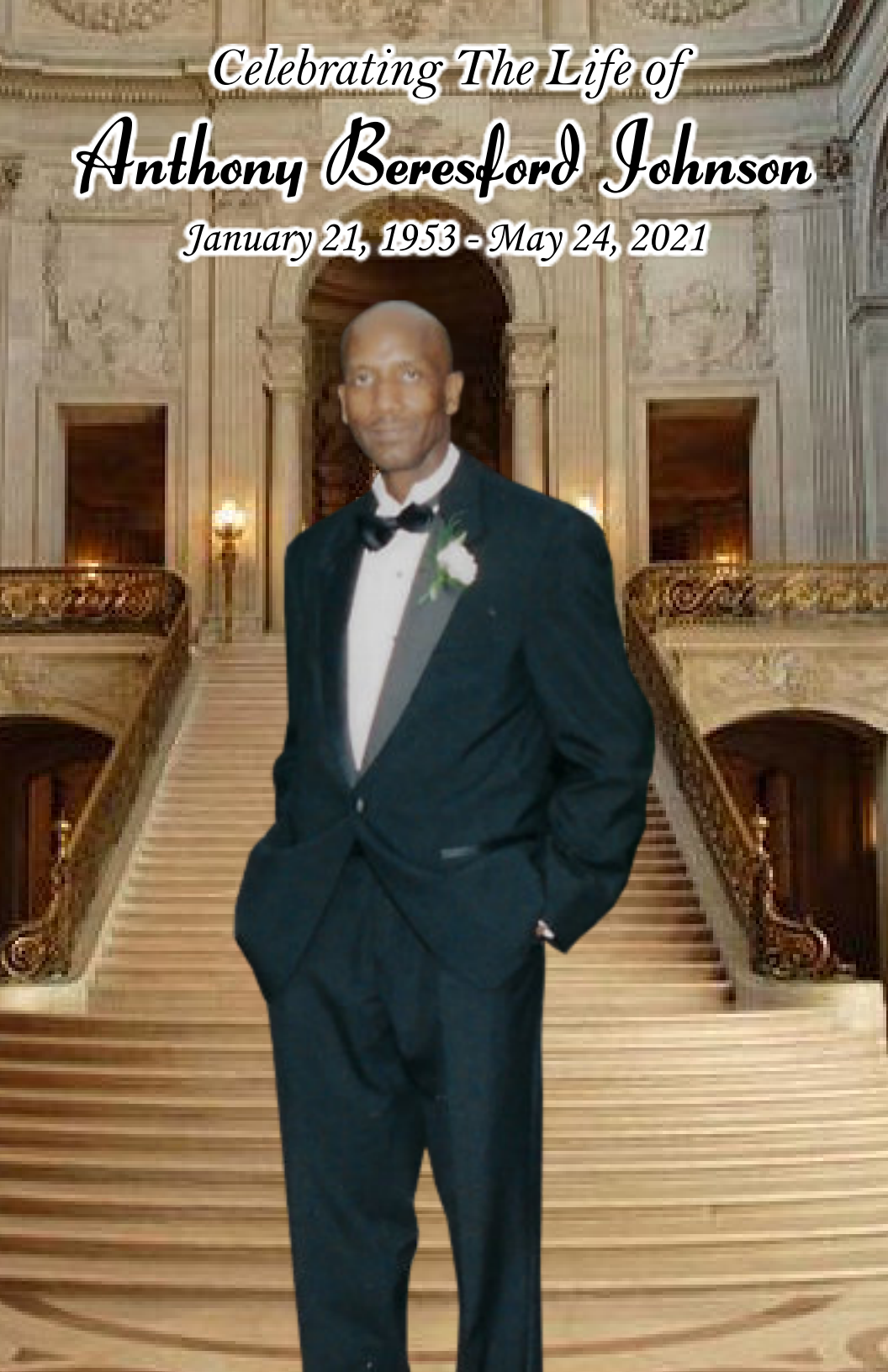

Obituary

Anthony Beresford Johnson; lovingly referred to as ‘Tony’; is the son of the late Agatha Johnson and Roderick Johnson, and was born on January 21, 1953, in Saint Catherine Jamaica. He was called home on May 24, 2021, after a brave battle with illness.
