Obituary

Julian Mark Olson James was born on the Island of Antigua. He was raised by his grandmother Millicent Samuel (deceased) until adolescence. He was always very helpful and conscientious to her until her passing. Fondly known as Ali to many back home in Antigua, he was very academically gifted, as was evident in his school studies. He attended the Antigua Villa School in his earlier years and then later went on to attend the Princess Margaret School (PM) where he graduated with honors.

Julian, along with his sisters and brothers, migrated to the Bronx, New York on August 2, 1988 to join their mother with great excitement. It was here that Julian attended William Howard Taft High School and did so well that he was allowed to graduate early. He was also awarded a scholarship from the Office of Bronx District Attorney, Robert Johnson, where he decided to pursue his post-secondary studies at Siena College in Loudonville, New York. Upon graduating from Siena in 1995, Julian accepted a job offer with Morgan Stanley. He later went on to work at Credit Suisse where he spent many years before recently accepting a job with NYCHHC doing his favorite thing – working with computers. Through the later part of his life, Julian met and lived with his partner, Valerie Martelly, who sadly passed away in October 2020. They

shared a passion for enjoying life and did everything together – traveling the world and being devoted to each other. She was his world.

Julian was known for having a big heart and his love extended to not just his family, but also his friends. He was loved dearly by his mother, Christobelle Tonge, and adored tremendously by his siblings. To him, family meant everything and he always strived to bring happiness and be a positive role model to them. To his friends, he was a caring, thoughtful, loyal, and fun-loving guy. In short, the love he exuded to others in his life was immeasurable. He will be dearly missed, but is now gone home to be with the Lord at the age of 50 years old.

Julian leaves to cherish his memories, his mother Christobelle Tonge, sisters -Tolani Isaac and Renaldo Cadle, brothers – Vaughn James and Mickel Tonge, and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews.

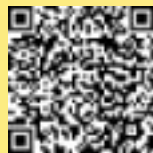
