Stanley Dash was born on October 20th, 1963, to (the late) Iris M. Dash. He attended PS 41 and IS 70 on the lower east side of Manhattan. Stanley then attended Dewitt Clinton High School in the Bronx, New York. He also attended CW Post College then Long Island University in Brooklyn, New York; where he obtained his Bachelors of Science in accounting.

Stanley enlisted in the United States Army at the age of 19. There he served thirty

years as a Sargent First Class Combat Medic. In the Army Stanley fought in Desert Storm and Operation Iraqi Freedom. There he received many medals of honor, awards and citations.
