## <u>Obituary</u>

Kenneth Green was a loving son, friend, artist, actor, and singer. He passed away on April 12, 2020 at the age of 54.

Kenny was born to Solomon Green and Deborah Elaine Green on June 24, 1965 in Bronx, New York. As a child, he joined Greater Victory Baptist Church in Bronx, NY under the pastorate of Reverend Grady Donald, who baptized him. At Greater Victory, Kenny was eventually chosen to teach Sunday School to children who ranged in age from 8 to 12. Kenny's elementary-school & junior-high education was at RT Hudson School, where he graduated at the top of his class. He attended high school at Northeastern Academy, where he graduated salutatorian of his class.

After high school, Kenny enlisted in the U.S. Marines where he served for six months before working in social services for several years. From 1997 to 2011, he worked in the food-service/hospitality industry, and from 2012 to 2020, he worked in Loss Prevention at Macy's department store.

In 2013, Kenny earned an Associate's Degree in Business Foundations at the University of Phoenix.

Kenny had three creative passions: art, acting, and singing. He was a gifted artist who enchanted many family members and friends with his dazzling drawings and sketches. He was also a respected thespian, performing in several stage productions in New York, at one point playing the major part of Fats Waller in the Off-Broadway musical "Ain't Misbehavin". Kenny's acting talent extended to productions abroad and even to some small roles in television and film. Additionally, he was an accomplished singer whose harmonizing talent enhanced many of the stage musicals he performed in; not long before his passing, he sang at a Rockefeller Center winter holiday event.

Kenny is survived by his mother Deborah; his brothers Michael, Jemal, Thaddeus, and Larry; his sisters Alicia and Cynthia; his nieces Tyra (and her husband Richard), Meagan, Joycelyn, Alexandria, and Alicia; his nephews, Nurrud-din (Buddy) and Brandon; his beloved friend Shey; and several aunts, uncles, and cousins.
