# Obituary



Solomon Green was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, and friend. He passed away on April 3, 2020 at the age of 79.

Sol was born to Orestes "Bogie" Green and Allie Golden Screen Green on October 15, 1940 in Fowlstown, Georgia (Decatur County). As a young child, he attended Emmanuel Missionary Baptist Church and was baptized there. He graduated from Attapulgus High School. A few years later, he left Georgia and moved to New York where his other sisters and brothers were living. While there, Sol met Deborah Elaine Bunch and a little later they were married: a union that lasted 55 years.

Sol worked for a furniture company for several years before going to work for the New York Transit Authority, where he put in 22 years of loyal, diligent service before retiring.

Shortly after retiring, Sol moved to Albion, NY to be with his wife Deborah, who worked there. While living in Albion, they both joined Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church under the pastorate of Reverend Ruben Goff, Jr. At Shiloh, Sol joined the adult choir and would often sing "I Am Redeemed"; the congregation was enchanted and inspired by his rendition few years, Pastor Goff had him ordained as Deacon. Sol also participated in ministries and studied doctrines provided by the Great Lakes Baptist Association. His favorite Bible scripture was Job 14:14, and his favorite hymn was "Near the Cross".

Among family and friends, Sol was admired for many things, including his generosity, great sense of humor, and especially his cooking skills. Just about all his nieces and nephews said they lived for Thanksgiving, when the house would often be packed with several relatives wanting and waiting to feast on Sol's delicious food. His cooking was so impressive that all of the kids, upon departing, would "put in their reservations" for the next year.

Sol is survived by his children Alicia (and her husband Herbert), Larry (and his wife Cheryl), Cynthia, Kenneth (alive at the time of his passing, he passed away nine days later), Michael, Jemal, and Thaddeus; his grandchildren Meagan, Joycelyn, Tyra (and her husband Richard), Alexandria, and Alicia, Nurrud-din (Buddy) and Brandon; his great-grandchild Josiah; his son-in-law John; his sister Lillian Bolden (alive at the time of his passing, she passed away in June 2020) and his brother Wallace Green (and his wife Alene); his brothers-in-law William (Bill) Ambrister Sr., William Bunch (and his wife Mattie), Michael, Ralph, and Dawud (and his wife Delores); his sisters-in-law Leah and Tammanika (and her husband Abdallah); and several nieces and nephews.

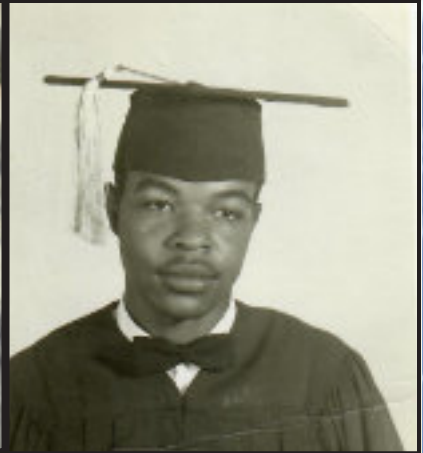
