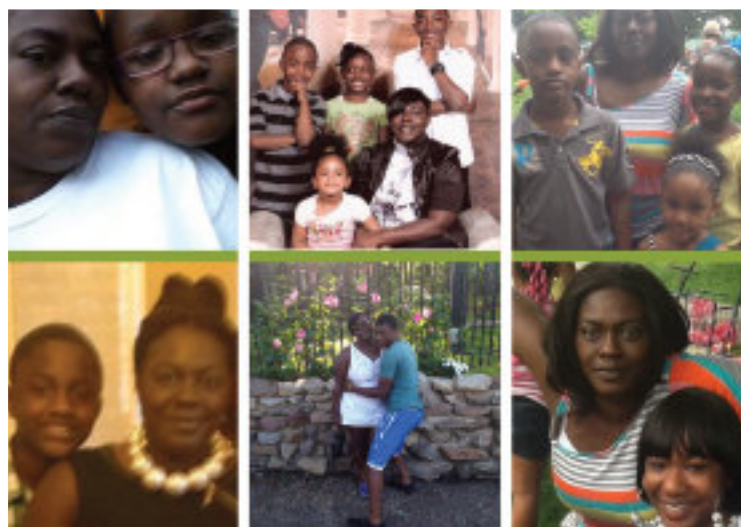

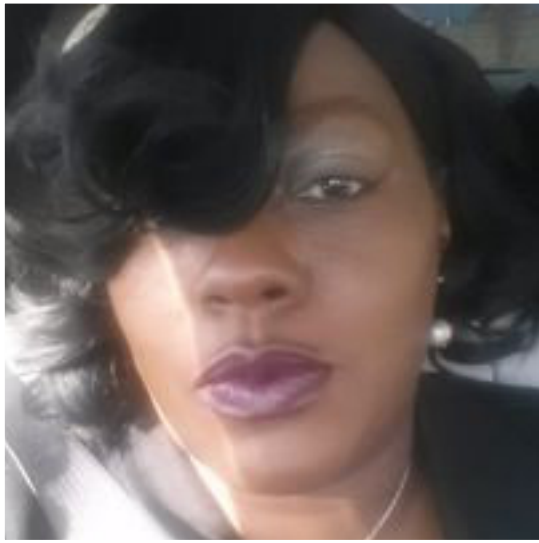

My Journey's Just Begun

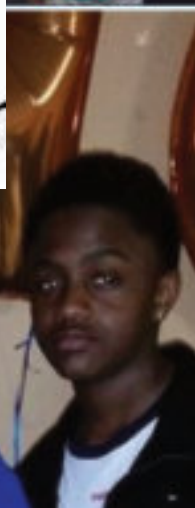


Don't think of me as gone away

where there are no days and years.

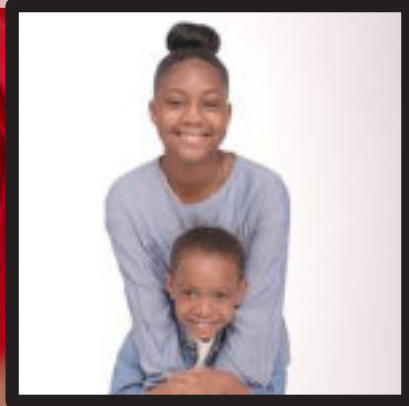
Think how I must be wishing
