Growing up as a child, attended Agbado Primary School. He had his secondary education at Immaculate Conception College where he graduated in the The year 1988. He attended the University of Benin, Nigeria where he studied Medicine and graduated in 1998. He later left Nigeria for Italy the year 2001 in search of greener pastures and later migrated to the United States of America where he resided.

His singing ministry began in the year 1992 in Benin, at the Christ Apostolic Church Of God Mission founded by the Late Apostle (Dr.) Samuel Enoragbon Ogbonmwan, a renowned Gospel Singer and the Founder of the Voice of The Glad Tidings Singers of Blessed Memory. He late Founder, Apostle (Dr.) S. E Ogbonmwan was his mentor. He is a prolific Vocalist and a Sensational Trumpeter. He sang and blew the trumpet in the Glad Tidings Singers Band led by Late Apostle (Dr.) S. E. Ogbonmwan. He featured in the hit songs like Giagbonmwen ghaye, in the 12th album of the Late Legend Apostle (Dr.) S.E Ogbonmwan before he left Nigeria for Italy where he had his two wonderful sons: Nosafiangbe and Praise Aiyosagie Okunwague in the year 2005 and 2007 respectively. He composed & produced his debut album "Ariobosa" in the year 2007. Thousands of copies were sold within a few weeks of its release. At the moment, he has hit singles and was currently working on his new album which will be released soon. He has been nominated for the Jokers Award that took place October 2020 in Nigeria as the Best Art of the Year (Diaspora).

He was a wonderful and dedicated father and husband, brother and friends. He was caring and well principled. He loved the Lord and he was very passionate about using his talent as a song writer, Vocalist, and a great singer to give praise to the Lord. He was loved by anyone that knew him. He survived by his wife -Dorcas Ojiemwenkode Okunwague and two children, Praise Aiyosagie Okunwague and Mine Nosafiangbe Okunwague. His brothers, sisters, extended Family and friends.
