Obituary



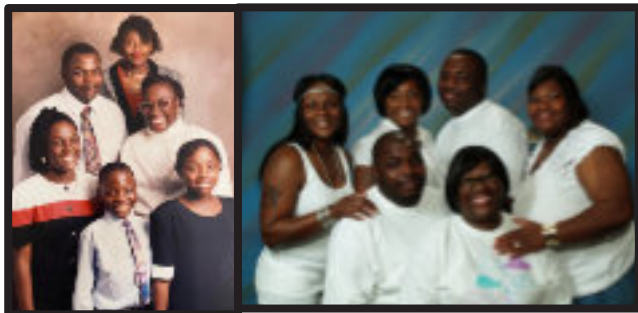
