Hudson was known for his infamous grunt of saying "uh uh," when he disagreed with you and playfully called people "crazy" with hand gestures.

In his spare time, his passion was listening to his music, watching movies, sport programs and his computer. The enhancement of these activities was shared with his close friends on the first floor in his Harlem residence. (Gerald, Joseph and Lamont). He enjoyed going downtown for walks. His long legs would get him to his destination in a flash.
