Obituary

Clarine Hill Mullen was born on May 15, 1943 in Jackson, N.C., the second of eight children, to the late Janie J. Jones and Robert Lee Harris. While in Jackson she attended Eastside School and worked on the farm. In 1965, she moved to Paterson, NJ, where she began working at Spotless Cleaners before becoming self employed as a caregiver; both to the elderly and children. A selfless and loving person, she was known to most as "Sis", and was Grandma to all of the children for which she provided care over the years. She loved taking care of others, and enjoyed working on puzzle books, and watching soap operas and game shows.

Clarine was a devoted member of the New Shiloh Baptist Church for over 55 years, having served as President of the Senior Ushers' Board, Vice President of the Senior Missionary Board, Treasurer of the Deaconess Board, and singing on multiple choirs. She was a Prayer Warrior who loved attending church, reading and studying the Bible, and faithfully being on the prayer line with praying partners.
